

Angels' Meadow Informational Packet

The Lord has blessed us with the beautiful Angels' Meadow venue campground and we are excited to share it with you! We provide the space, you bring the food and supplies. Therefore, unless mentioned below, assume you will need to bring anything you want. It feels rural, but we are within 15 minutes of a Target store if your group needs to purchase last minute items.

AMENITIES

Cabins

- Six rustic buildings with two rooms each
- Each room sleeps 5 people
- There are no bathrooms or sinks in the cabins
- There are lights and electrical outlets

Camping Sites

- 14 tent sites, 11 in the Lower (tenting) Meadow, 2 by Archery, 1 by the Swim Pond
- 4 RV sites (no hookups)
- No tenting allowed in Angels' Meado

Bathrooms

- Two handicap bathrooms each with a shower
- Male and female bathrooms with multiple stalls and showers
- Hand soap

Kitchen

- Large BBQ - grill & stovetop
- Counter tops
- Sink with hot and cold water
- Electricity
- Fridges

Stage/Amphitheater

- Seats 150+
- Electricity available at the stage

Swimming

- Inquire prior to camp about use and lifeguarding
- All of the "toys" at the pond are available for use (includes canoes, paddle boards, floaties)

Ponds

- Fishing is permitted for catch and release

Camp Fire

- There is a fire pit with amphitheater style seating
- You can use our firewood and gather branches as well
- Safety protocol:
 - Always monitored by an adult
 - Have a hose and shovel on stand-by (there is a hose nearby)
 - Before walking away from the fire, you must hose the fire pit down and use the shovel to stir. The fire pit must be cool enough to run your hands through it.
 - Rake leaves and brush 10 feet around the fire pit
 - Do not use paper to start your fire (pine needles work great!)

Disc Golf

- There is a humble 18 hole disc golf course throughout our property with poles as baskets available for use

High Ropes (officially inquire for details) - Not available at the moment

- Must be run by CER staff, whose pay must be covered

MEADOW RULES

***NO SUBSTANCE USE OF ANY KIND - INCLUDING ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, & VAPING
NO PETS ALLOWED***

Quiet Hours

- We have neighbors immediately across the canal from the meadow. WE MUST respect them by strictly enforcing quiet hours.
- No sound amplification from 9:30 PM until 8 AM
- No programming louder than normal conversation from 10pm - 7am

Food & Trash

- Secure food and trash before you go to sleep each night
- There is a food shed right next to the kitchen where you can store food overnight with refrigeration
- We have a trash shed in the meadow to put trash bags in
- Bring trash bags for our cans
- You must haul away all your trash

Parking

- Parking is limited. Please carpool as much as possible, or arrange drop-offs.
- There are about 20 parking spots up by the camp. (We can get creative with additional parking if needed.)
- Please do not drive past the chains onto the grass. Use wagons to deliver supplies to the kitchen and gear to cabins.

Upon Arrival:

- Waivers must be turned in for every person. (Can be done online ahead of time.)
- Deposit must be paid. (Should be done online ahead of time.)

Upon Departure:

- Complete necessary cleaning tasks based upon amenity use.
- Fill out Exit Form and submit before leaving property

WHAT TO BRING

- Sheets
- Pillows
- Sleeping bags, etc.
- Food and cooking utensils
- Propane & lighters
- Toilet paper & paper towels
- Amplification equipment (if using amphitheater)
- Discs (if using disc golf course)

WHAT THE RANCH PROVIDES

- Cleaning supplies (located in kitchen shed and bathrooms)
- Electricity
- Running water
- Guest speaker for your group if desired
